What Is GIS?

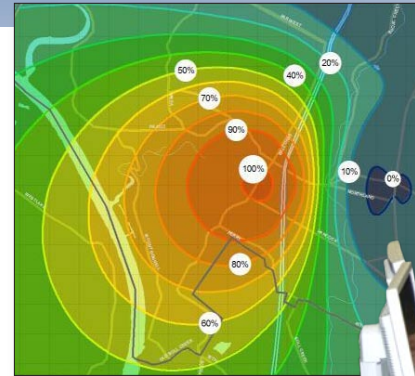
